## Hebrew Free Loan Society of Greater Philadelphia **Privacy Policy**

Updated and adopted by the Board of Directors May 13, 2025

The directors, officers, and staff of HFL understand present and past applicants, borrowers, and guarantors furnish sensitive information to us when requesting or guaranteeing a loan. We are committed to treating your nonpublic\* personal information responsibly.

We collect nonpublic\* personal information about you from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you on loan applications and government-issued personal identification:
- Information we receive from your guarantors or co-signers;
- Information about your transactions with us or others; and
- Information we receive from credit reporting agencies.

\*Nonpublic personal information is nonpublic information about you that we obtain in connection with processing a loan request, providing a loan, or receiving a loan guarantee. This includes information about your account balance, payment history, and overdraft history.

We do not disclose any nonpublic personal information about you, except as permitted by law. We may report non-payment of your debt to credit reporting agencies, as well as to your co-signers.

We will continue to adhere to the privacy policies and practices as described in this notice even after you satisfy your loan obligation to us.

Your confidence in us is important and we want you to know that your personal information is safe.
